

Attendance


Attendance was taken; 8 members were in attendance.

Minutes from 2/21/19 Meeting

Minutes from the February meeting were approved without correction by voice vote. No further business matters were discussed and the entire remainder of the meeting was devoted to Doug Hutzell's presentation on the Beaver Creek Watershed.

Beaver Creek Watershed Presentation

Doug presented tables showing past results of benthic samplings in the Beaver Creek Watershed. Typical of spring creeks, Beaver Creek had high numbers of scuds and cressbugs whereas freestone creeks in the watershed had higher numbers of stoneflies, mayflies, caddis and other larvae. Benthic samplings follow a set of standards established by DNR to allow for statistical comparisons. Benthic samples are strained through sieves and insect and animal samples are placed in vials filled with alcohol which are sent to DNR for identification. This year's first sampling was cancelled due high water. Doug is requesting volunteers to help with future benthic surveys.
